VIRGINIA STATE POLICE Advanced Defensive Tactics Instructor Training August 24 – 25, 2017

The Virginia State Police will sponsor a two-day Advanced Defensive Tactics Instructor Training course to be held at the **Virginia State Police Academy**, North Chesterfield, Virginia. This training will focus on current trends, police officer assaults, and recovering from standing and prone positions. Virginia State Police will be providing instruction for this training. The two-day course will include the following topics:

- Sudden Attacks
- Striking Techniques
- Standing and Prone Combat
- Ground Combat

There is no tuition fee for this course. Attendees will be responsible for their own meal and lodging arrangements.

Space is limited, so early registration is recommended.

DESCRIPTION: The purpose of this school is to provide advanced defensive tactics instructor training only to Department of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) certified and active defensive tactics instructors. It is intended to motivate and present a combined system of skills and attitudes, and to advance new ideas coupled with existing technique. This training will emphasize skill of technique rather than power.

PRE-REQUISITES: Students exhibiting pre-existing medical problems that instructional staff believe could likely lead to injury will be returned to their agency without training. Individuals should be in good health and able to participate in strenuous exercises. In addition, they will be subjected to mental stress, physical stress, and physical confrontations with instructors and other participants. A medical examination is recommended.

Participants must be sworn law enforcement officers, and must be a certified DCJS defensive tactics instructor.

PRIORITY: The above deadline for submission of application will be strictly observed as class size is limited. Participants will be selected according to the order in which responses are received.

IN-SERVICE CREDIT: 16 hours of career development in-service credit will be awarded upon successful completion.

TUITION: No charge.

MEALS: Not provided by the Virginia State Police Academy and at the responsibility of the participants.

LODGING: Not provided by the Virginia State Police Academy.

ATTIRE: The uniform for the training will be BDU pants, T-shirt, and tennis shoes. In addition, duty belt and handcuffs are required during practical exercises at the gym. Appropriate attire must be worn in the cafeteria during breaks. Academy rules prohibit wearing jeans, shorts, sweatshirts, sweatpants, and flip flops.

PARKING: Attendees should park in designated areas and not in front of the Academy or reserved parking areas.

DEADLINE: **June 30, 2017**, at close of business, to submit application.

ACCEPTANCE: Individuals will be notified whether they have been selected to attend this training. Accepted applicants will receive an information packet. Please review closely.
